Life Group Discussion Questions

1 Corinthians 11:1

Sharing the Joy – January 29, 2023

1. What are some hobbies or skills that you've learned from someone else? What was the process for learning these? What hobbies/skills have you taught others? How did that go?
2. Considering Jesus' life and ministry, what are some of the skills/habits/disciplines that Jesus modeled for His closest followers?
3. Who are the people in your life that imitate Jesus that you want to imitate? How have they modeled Jesus for you? How can you get more of that?
4. How would you put this phrase into your own words - "expectantly inviting others to imitate us" (as we imitate Jesus)?
5. In what contexts do you already lead others? (Ex: In the home, at work, on the pickle-ballcourt, etc.?) What could it look like to invite them to imitate you as you imitate Jesus?
6. As we process Week 3 of Sharing the Joy, what ways can you be happier in Jesus today (than you were yesterday)?
