5. In what ways do we move away from the Gospel of salvation by grace through faith without realizing it?
6. What do you believe are the effects God intends to produce in our life through the belief in salvation by grace alone? How does that impact our thoughts, feelings and actions?
7. How might you lovingly, humbly initiate this conversation with a Roman Catholic friend? Others in your sphere of influence?
