



Isaiah 9:6

⁶ For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, <u>Prince of Peace</u>.



There is a desperate need for peace. Hostilities are high.

- COVID irritation
- Political anger
- Racial tension
- General frustration



Jesus is the Prince of Peace.



- Our sin makes us enemies of God and subjects us to...
 - The penalties of sin
 - The schemes of the devil
 - The brokenness of creation
 - Death (spiritual and physical)



Being enemies of God is the source of our lack of peace.



Romans 5:8,10 - ...while we were still sinners, Christ died for us...if while <u>we were enemies</u> we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.



Romans 5:1 - Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ.



Peace with God = Salvation

Luke 2:10-11

¹⁰ And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. ¹¹ For unto you is born this day in the city of David a <u>Savior</u>, who is Christ the Lord.

Being restored to God is the source of our peace.



Jesus brings peace with God.

Our lives are transformed:

- Enemies Children
- Hostility \longrightarrow PEACE

Philippians 4:7

⁷ And the <u>peace of God</u>, which <u>surpasses all</u> <u>understanding</u>, will <u>guard your hearts and your</u> <u>minds</u> in Christ Jesus.



How Will He Guard?

John 14:26-27 – But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. ²⁷Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.



Regarding The Rule of Sin

Romans 8:1-2 – There is therefore now <u>no</u> <u>condemnation</u> for those who are in Christ Jesus. ² For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.



Regarding The Enemy

Romans 8:38-39 – For I am sure that neither death nor life, <u>nor angels</u> nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, <u>nor anything else in all creation</u>, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.



Regarding Our Broken World

John 16:33 – I have said these things to you, that <u>in</u> <u>me you may have peace</u>. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; <u>I have overcome the</u> <u>world</u>.



Regarding Eternal Death

John 10:27-28 – My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸ <u>I give them eternal life</u>, and they will never perish, and <u>no one will snatch</u> <u>them out of my hand</u>.



The Prince of Peace Produces peace in us.

Jesus brings us inner, personal, surpassing peace.

- Security in God's love
- Significance in being children of God



The Prince of Peace empowers us to bring this peace to others.

Hostility:

- Not getting our way (Security)
- Not being valued (Significance)

Peace:

- Security in God's provision
- Significance in being children of God
- Significance in being vessels of God's grace PRIN of F

The Prince of Peace empowers us to bring this peace to others.

The Opportunities Are Almost Endless –

- When we are not getting our way
- When those around us are not getting their way
- When we are not being valued
- When those around us are not being valued



2 Corinthians 5:17-20

¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. ¹⁸ All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. ²⁰ Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

- His peace will one day completely saturate all of creation
- His peace will never come to an end
