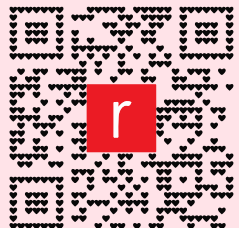

Helping Locally/Globally

How We Invest in Our Local Community

- HIS-OC - a Homeless Intervention Shelter in Placentia that serves and empowers families in our community who are on the verge of homelessness
- Living Well - a crisis pregnancy center in Orange that provides medical resources and support for young women, infants, and families in our community
- Safe Families - a partner organization that supports local families in crisis by hosting vulnerable children and providing support for socially-isolated families

How We Invest Globally

- As a community, we support eight families who have dedicated their lives to spreading the gospel in Africa, Asia, and Europe, as well as immigrant populations within our own borders. We are also the primary source of support for seven pastors in Kosova, which enables them to be full-time pastors to their neighborhoods.
