2. How does he answer the above question in chapter 9? Chapter 10?
3. What does Paul refer to by the “then” in 11:1?
4. What evidence does Paul give for his answer, “by no means!”?
5. What does Paul mean by “foreknew” in verse 2?
6. Who is Elijah and what is his accusation and appeal to God?
7. Why does Paul use this and the 7,000 as an example?
8. What is a remnant?
9. Why does Paul say “chosen by grace”? Is there any significance to adding the word “chosen”?
10. Why does Paul seem to emphasize grace so emphatically?
11. How would you summarize the big idea of Chapter 11:1-6?

**How does it apply?**

1. Have you ever had a hard time trusting people? Why?
2. Why is Paul's answer to the question in verse 1 important to you today?
3. Have you ever been confident about how God was going to handle a certain situation and it didn't turn out the way you thought/wanted? What was that like?
4. What is it about who God is (and what he has done in your past) that compels you to trust more fully today?
5. How have you felt 'chosen by grace' this past year? Give specific examples
6. In what ways do you live differently as a result of your answer to question 4?
