What does it mean?

1. How would you summarize Paul's big idea in 11:1-10?
2. Who is the "they" in v.11?
3. How did "they" stumble?
4. What is the difference between stumbling and falling?
5. What are the riches that "their" trespass has brought to Gentiles?
6. What is "their full inclusion"? Who? Gets included where? When does this happen?
7. What does Paul mean when he says, "I magnify my ministry"?
8. How did Paul's magnifying his ministry make the Jews jealous?
9. Paul states that the Jew's acceptance (inclusion) will mean "life from the dead" for Gentiles. How does Paul intend us to understand "life from the dead" in this context?
10. What is Paul saying in 11:16?
11. How would you summarize 11:11-16?

How does it apply?

1. How do you feel about the Jews' stumbling leading to the gospel going to we Gentiles?
2. How does seeing God's plan laid out in these verses encourage your faith?
3. Does more clearly seeing God's long term plan encourage you to be even more dedicated to ministering on behalf of Jesus? Explain.
4. Do you sense that the joy we are experiencing in our faith at RCC is causing unbelievers to be jealous? Explain.
5. How do you feel about the plan God has for the Jews?
