Romans 11:33-36

[33] Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!

[34] “For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?” [35] “Or who

has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?” [36] For from him and through him

and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

The Righteousness of God: How a righteous God declares sinners (unrighteous people) righteous without compromising His own righteousness.



- The Problem: No one is righteous.
- The Solution: Jesus.
- The Response: Faith.
- The Experience: Those declared righteous are empowered by the Holy Spirit to live differently.
- The Plan: God is fulfilling his promise and plan.

A confidence in what we know about God leads us to the understanding that there is so much about God that is beyond our present understanding.

- God's riches are indescribable.
- God's wisdom is unimaginable.
- God's knowledge is incomprehensible.
- God's judgments are inconceivable.
- God's ways are unfathomable.



A confidence in what we know about God leads us to overwhelming humility.

- God's intellect is so infinitely profound we recognize it is infinitely beyond us.
- God is so smart that none of us can offer him any advice. On anything. Ever.
- God owns everything so there is no possible way we can give him anything.



A confidence in what we know about God leads us to pure, wholehearted, mind blowing, awe inspired exaltation.

- God is the source of everything.
- God is the one that makes everything work.
- God is the one for whom all things exist.
